

MARIANNA CITY COMMISSION
SPECIAL MEETING
FEBRUARY 10, 2010
4:00 PM

The Marianna City Commission met for a special meeting on the above date and time. Mayor Ephriam called the meeting to order. City Clerk, Kimberly J. Applewhite, called the roll. Members present were: Mayor Travis Ephriam, Kenneth Hamilton, John Roberts and Allen Ward, II. Commissioner Rico Williams was absent.

Mayor Ephriam gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Roberts, with a second by Commissioner Ward, the Commission voted unanimously to move approve the agenda as presented.

City Manager Jim Dean told the Commission that several months ago the Commission approved to dispose/sell the property located between Family Dollar Distribution Center and Hanson Pipe at Distribution Park. It consists of approx. 21 acres and is being sold by private sale for economic development purposes to Hickinbotham Holdings Marianna, LLC and selling price is \$1,500 per acre.

Resolution #2021-010 authorizes the sale of the surplus property for economic development purposes.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Roberts, with a second by Commissioner Ward, the Commission voted unanimously to approve Resolution #2021-010.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
