**ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF REPORT**

Subject: Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT)  
Utility Work by Highway Contractor Agreement  
Resolution 2022-015

Subject Background: FDOT is currently engaging in a project that requires minor modifications to City utilities along US 90 from Chipola River Bridge to east of SR 71. One item discussed was that the City has 5 manholes and 10 water valves that will need to be adjusted during construction.

There are two options:

A.) The City can perform the adjustments themselves during construction (handled in the Utility Work Schedule with all other items)

B.) The City can pay the contractor to do the adjustments via Utility Work by Highway Contractor Agreement (at City's expense) cost below:

5 manholes x \$1,650.00 per manhole = \$8,250.00

10 valves x \$715.00 per valve = \$7150.00

**Total = \$15,400.00**

City Staff desires to engage the services of FDOT to assist in raising 5 manholes and 10 valve boxes. FDOT is requesting a lump sum amount of \$15,400.00 for this service.

Recommendation: City Staff recommends approval of the Utility Work by Highway Contractor Agreement and Resolution 2022-015.

Potential Motion: I move to approve the Utility Work by Highway Contractor Agreement and Resolution 2022-015.
