

ORDINANCE NO. 1124

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF MARIANNA, FLORIDA, RELATING
TO CITY COMMISSION REDISTRICTING;
PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Marianna (“City”) is a municipality granted home rule authority pursuant to Article VIII, Section 2 of the Constitution of the State of Florida and may exercise its governmental, corporate and proprietary powers for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Marianna’s current commission districts are set forth in that certain final judgment in United States Norther District of Florida Case number 83-2064-MMP; and

WHEREAS, the City of Marianna, pursuant to the City of Marianna Charter §6.05(b), is directed to evaluate and its commission districts following the decennial census; and

WHEREAS, the City of Marianna has followed the requirement of the City of Marianna Charter §6.05 and appointed a redistricting committee and said committee has determined that the current districts constitute equal and effective representation as required by the United States Constitution and as represented in the mathematical preciseness reached in the legislative apportionment of the state; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARIANNA, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF DISTRICT BOUNDARIES:

The City Commission Districts shall remain as set forth in that certain final judgment in United States Norther District of Florida Case number 83-2064-MMP.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY.

If any word, phrase, clause, section or portion of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

THIS ORDINANCE shall be effective immediately upon passage.
