

## **RESOLUTION      2022- 019**

**WHEREAS**, in March 2021, the American Rescue Plan Act was signed into law, and established the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund and Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds, which together make up the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recover Funds (SLFRF) program. This program is intended to provide support to State, territorial, local, and Tribal governments in responding to the economic and public health impacts of COVID-19 and in their efforts to contain impacts on communities, residents, and businesses;

**WHEREAS**, in May 2021 the US Treasury published the Interim Final Rule describing eligible and ineligible uses of funds, and went into immediate effect to allow governments to have use of SLFRF funds to meet their immediate pandemic response needs;

**WHEREAS**, in January 2022 the US Treasury published the Final Rule, with an Effective Date of April 1, 2022, which provides broader flexibility and greater simplicity in the SLFRF program, in response to the comment process for adoption;

**WHEREAS**, the Final Rule offers a standard allowance for revenue loss of \$10 million, allowing recipients to select between a standard amount of revenue loss or complete a full revenue loss calculation;

**WHEREAS**, Recipients that select the standard allowance may use that amount – in many cases their full award – for government services, with streamlined reporting requirements. Government services generally include any service traditionally provided by a government, including construction of roads and other infrastructure;

**BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City of Marianna, Florida, the following:**

That the City Commission declares funding received by the City of Marianna, FL as a result of the American Rescue Plan Act be declared as Lost Revenue effective as of the date of the effective date of the Final Rule April 1, 2022.
