

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-021

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF MARIANNA CITY COMMISSION, FLORIDA, APPROVING APPLICATION(S) FOR A STATE OF FLORIDA, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT MITIGATION PROGRAM (CDBG-MIT PROGRAM) FOR CONSTRUCTION OF INFRASTRUCTURE AND MITIGATION IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE CITY OF MARIANNA PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, The State of Florida has established the Community Development Block Grant Mitigation Program, and it has been determined the City of Marianna is eligible to make application for certain funds under this program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Marianna has identified the following priority projects as central to the Hurricane Michael recovery effort as part of mitigation and resiliency:

- 1) **The City of Marianna Resiliency Hub Project: to better shelter and serve the population before, during, and after disasters. Estimated Cost \$5,987,600.00**
- 2) **The Jackson Hospital Utility and Access Hardening Project: to harden the utilities and transportation infrastructure to improve access to life saving medical care during and after disasters. Estimated Cost \$5,648,300.00**
- 3) **The Market Street/US 90 Electrical Utility Hardening Project: to harden electrical utilities in the City Center to improve private and public sector continuity during disaster events. Estimated Cost \$5,202,400.00**

The City intends to submit grant funding applications to the Rebuild Florida Infrastructure Program Mitigation Program for the City of Marianna; and

WHEREAS, the grant program requires a public hearing to be held and the project be approved by the City Commission.

WHEREAS, the Mayor Pro-Tem and the City Manager have authority and rights to execute all required grant related application and agreement documents in the absence of the Town Council President, including acting as a Certifying Officer under Section 104(g) of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended (42

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U.S.C. 5304 (g)) (HUD Act), in connection with the receipt of assistance from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) under Title I of the HUD Act (or refer to specific assistance from HUD). Such authority hereby delegated includes, but is not limited to, the authority to execute the certification required under Section 104 (g) of the HUD Act; the authority to specify when appropriate that the jurisdiction has fully carried out its responsibilities for environmental review, decision making and action under Section 104(g) (1) if the HUD Act; the authority to consent to assume the status of a responsible Federal Official under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and other provisions of law specified in the regulations of HUD in 24 CFR Part 58;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City of Marianna City Commission, Florida, that submission of the CDBG-MIT application for certain improvements and associated signature authority is hereby approved.
