ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF REPORT

Subject: 2021/22 Lift Station Rehabilitation Project

Subject Background: The City engaged the services of Alday/Howell Engineering in 2021 to do the design work and solicitation of bids on four lift stations in our system that are needing repairs/upgrades. City received bids for the subject project on Thursday, June 23,2022 at 2pm. Three contractors submitted bids with Martin Construction, LLC submitting the lowest overall qualified bid.

City Commission approved at the July 7th meeting to award work to Martin Construction. At the time City staff wanted to complete one lift station in this year’s budget and follow through with the remaining three in 22/23 budget year. After talking in detail further with all staff involved we would like to go ahead and move forward with work with all stations. City staff will need to spend roughly 343,000.00 out of Leachate reserve funds to complete the work in this years budget.

Recommendation: Based on the attached letter from Alday/Howell Engineering City staff recommends we award bid to Martin Construction, LLC for Lift Station Rehab work.

Potential Motion: Move to approve contract with Martin Construction, LLC.
