A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARIANNA AS THE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES OF CHAPTER 163, PART III, FLORIDA STATUTES AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Marianna has declared a portion of the downtown to be suitable for redevelopment, and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has declared the need for the creation of a Community Redevelopment Agency to effectuate the purposes of The Community Redevelopment Act of 1969 (Chapter 163, Part III, Florida Statutes), and


WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Marianna deems it appropriate to exercise its authority under Chapter 163.157, Florida Statutes.

NOW THEREFORE , BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Marianna:

- 1) That the City Commission of the City of Marianna is hereby declared to be the Community Redevelopment Agency for the City of Marianna.
- 2) The Community Redevelopment Agency shall have all the rights, powers, duties, and privileges granted under Chapter 163, Part III, Florida Statutes.

ORDINANCE NO. 822

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A REDEVELOPMENT TRUST FUND FOR THE MARIANNA COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY

WHEREAS, the Marianna City Commission has created a Community Redevelopment Agency in accordance with Florida Statutes, Chapter 163.357(1)a, and


WHEREAS, Florida Statutes, Chapter 163.387, mandates the establishment of a redevelopment trust fund for each community redevelopment agency established under the law. Such fund to be used by the agency to finance or refinance any community redevelopment it undertakes pursuant to the approved Community Redevelopment Plan. Annual funding of which will be in accordance with the procedures set forth in Florida Statutes, Chapter 163.387.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Marianna that a redevelopment trust fund for the Marianna Redevelopment Agency is hereby established.

Adopted this the 9th day of JUNE, 1993 as an emergency ordinance.

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held for receiving citizens comments on the amended plan; now therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED that the City Commission of the City of Marianna adopts the Amended Community Redevelopment Plan dated March, 1995.

WHEREAS, the Main Street Marianna Committee possesses specific insights and abilities in achieving these goals, now therefore,


